

**TOWN OF CALMAR  
BYLAW #2011-07**

**A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF CALMAR, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AMEND BYLAW #2008-08, BEING THE WATER, WASTEWATER, SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLING BYLAW, TO REGULATE THE PURCHASE OF BULK WATER BY RURAL AGRICULTURAL USERS.**

**WHEREAS**, Bylaw #2008-08 establishes the rates payable by bulk water consumers in SCHEDULE 'A' of the aforesaid Bylaw, and

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Town of Calmar, wishes to amend the rates for bulk water purchases by rural agricultural consumers,

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the Town of Calmar, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. The Section listed as BULK WATER RATES, in SCHEDULE 'A' of Bylaw #2008-08 is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced by the following:

**"BULK WATER RATES**

- a) Bulk water consumers shall be required to pay a key deposit in the amount of \$25.00 and \$10.00 of the said deposit will be retained by the Town as a non-refundable administration fee.
  - b) Commercial and Industrial consumers shall be billed, on a monthly basis, a minimum charge of \$25.00 for the first 3 cubic meters, or portion thereof, and \$5.00 per cubic meter thereafter.
  - c) Rural agricultural consumers are hereby defined as owners of bonafide farming operations. These consumers are required to provide the Town of Calmar with their legal land description at the time of registration for a bulk water account.  
Rural agricultural consumers are required to pay the Town of Calmar an Annual Administration Fee of \$50.00.  
Rural agricultural consumers shall be billed, on a monthly basis, a rate of \$3.00 per cubic meter, or portion thereof."
2. These rates shall come into full force and effect on May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011.


