

**TOWN OF CALMAR
BYLAW #2010-13**

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF CALMAR, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AMEND BYLAW #2008-08, BEING THE WATER, WASTEWATER, SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLING BYLAW.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority and provisions of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26, R.S.A 2000, and amendments thereto, the Council of the Town of Calmar may regulate the collection and disposal of solid waste, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Calmar wish to promote the use of recycling initiatives by residents and businesses within the Town of Calmar, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Calmar wish to reduce the amount of solid waste, being transferred to the Regional Solid Waste Facility, from within the Town of Calmar.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Calmar, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:


1. SCHEDULE "D" TO BYLAW #2008-08 is hereby amended by the removal of the wording "maximum of three (3) cans or six (6) bags" from Section 1 a) and in its place inserting the wording "maximum of two (2) cans or four (4) bags".

2. This Bylaw shall be effective January 1st, 2011.
