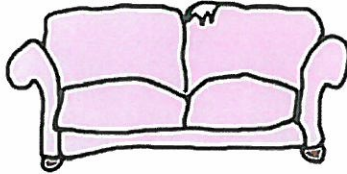

## CALMAR RECYCLING AND PEACE OFFICER INFORMATION 2012



**Blue Bag Service**

The Town of Calmar is proud to launch a Blue Bag Recycling Program with curb side pick-up every other Monday. The Blue Bag Program accepts tin cans, glass jars, plastic, flattened cardboard, newsprint and mixed paper. We are pleased to offer this service without an increase to ratepayers.



**Large Items**

The Town collects large items to a maximum of one tonne per residence in May (Tuesday to Friday following Victoria Day) and in the first week of October. The Town cannot accept concrete, tires, propane, bottles, appliances, auto parts, paint, oil, antifreeze or chemicals.

Please place metal in separate pile.



**Organic Waste**

Residents can place grass clippings and yard waste in clear plastic bags for collection every Monday, May through October. Clear bags must be as specified and placed in the front yard for pick-up. Branches in 3-foot bundles are collected with other large items during spring and fall clean-up.



**Hazardous Waste**

Residents take Hazardous Waste to the Leduc and District Landfill Site 4 KM East of Leduc on Rollyview Road. The Site is open year round Monday through Saturday from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM, with extended hours (to 9:00 PM) on Wednesday between May 1 and September 14. There is no charge for regular residential toxic waste materials. Call 780-986-4202 for more information.

**Peace Officer Information**

Calmar employs a Director of Protective Services and two full-time Peace Officers appointed by the Solicitor General of the Province of Alberta. These personnel are responsible for the enforcement of all Provincial Statutes and Regulations as well as the municipal bylaws. We have active mutual aid agreements in place with the City of Leduc and the County of Leduc, and have current contracts with the Villages of Thorsby, Warburg and Breton. The department has implemented and followed through on such programs as Calmar Citizens On Patrol, child safety seat inspections clinics, school talks and presentations, bike and bike helmet safety programs, and working in conjunction with the local emergency services on educational check stops such as the annual Santa Check Stop.
